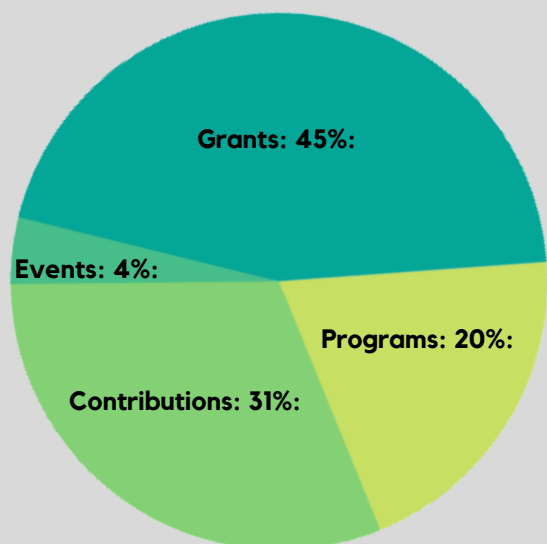
Mission Statement: To help community members in need in Bucks and Montgomery counties by offering a comprehensive array of social services that educate, encourage and empower them to become self-sufficient.

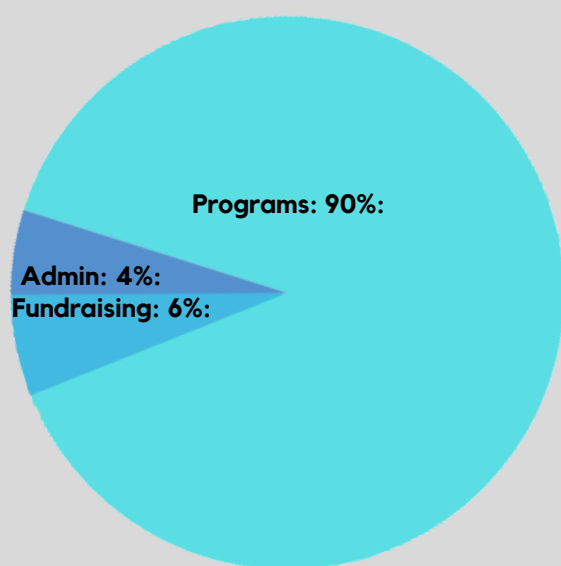
2017 HIGHLIGHTS

EDUCATION

Keystone educated 385 students in High School Equivalency, English as a Second Language, College and Career English, Family Literacy and Citizenship Test Preparation.

HOUSING

Keystone housing programs provided more than 120 households with Emergency Shelter, Rapid Rehousing or Transitional Housing and offered budgeting and financial advice to help 308 households. Keystone also owns and operates 28 low income housing properties which served 30 households.

FOOD

Keystone distributed more than 235,000 lbs of food and personal items to clients in Bucks and Montgomery Counties during 2,884 visits to our pantry in 2017.
