

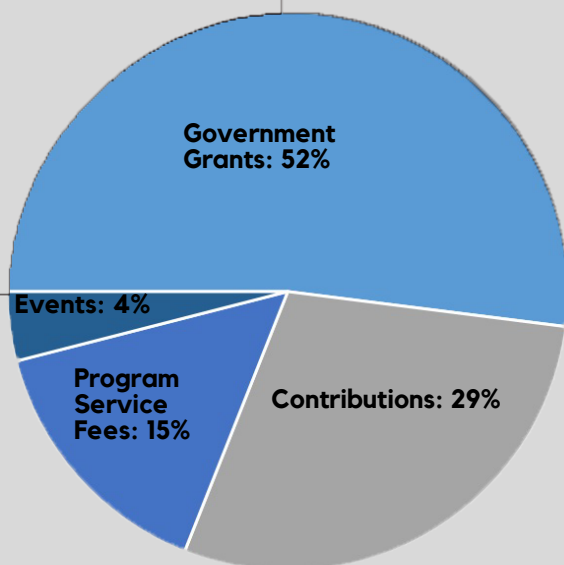

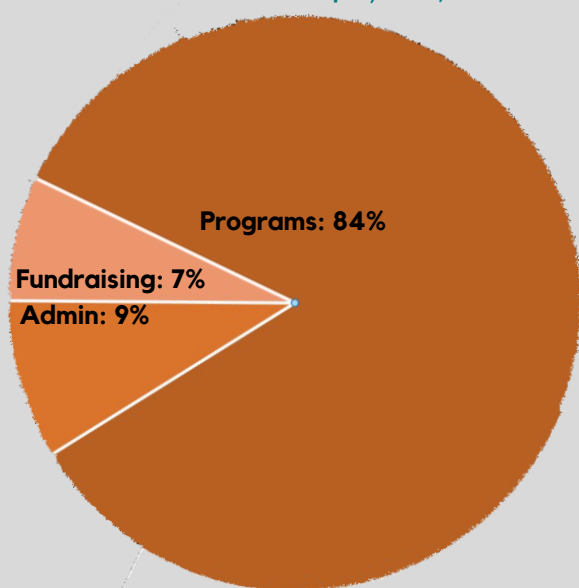
Mission Statement: To help community members in need in Bucks and Montgomery counties by offering a comprehensive array of social services that educate, encourage and empower them to become self-sufficient.

HOW MANY DO WE SERVE?

Approximately 5,000 individuals:
3,500 via pantry services, 1,000 via housing and community services, and 500 via education services.

EDUCATION

We expanded classes into Willow Grove and Norristown and educated 542 students including High School Equivalency, ESL, College and Career English, Family Literacy and Citizenship Test Preparation.

HOUSING

Our housing programs provided more than 100 individuals with affordable housing and assisted 900 individuals with housing, budgeting and financial advice. Our Community Case Manager fielded 1,187 phone calls and met with 314 individuals.

FOOD

We distributed nearly 400,000 lbs of food through our Food Insecurity programs: 263,594 lbs through our Food Pantry and 132,704 lbs through our Fresh For All program.
